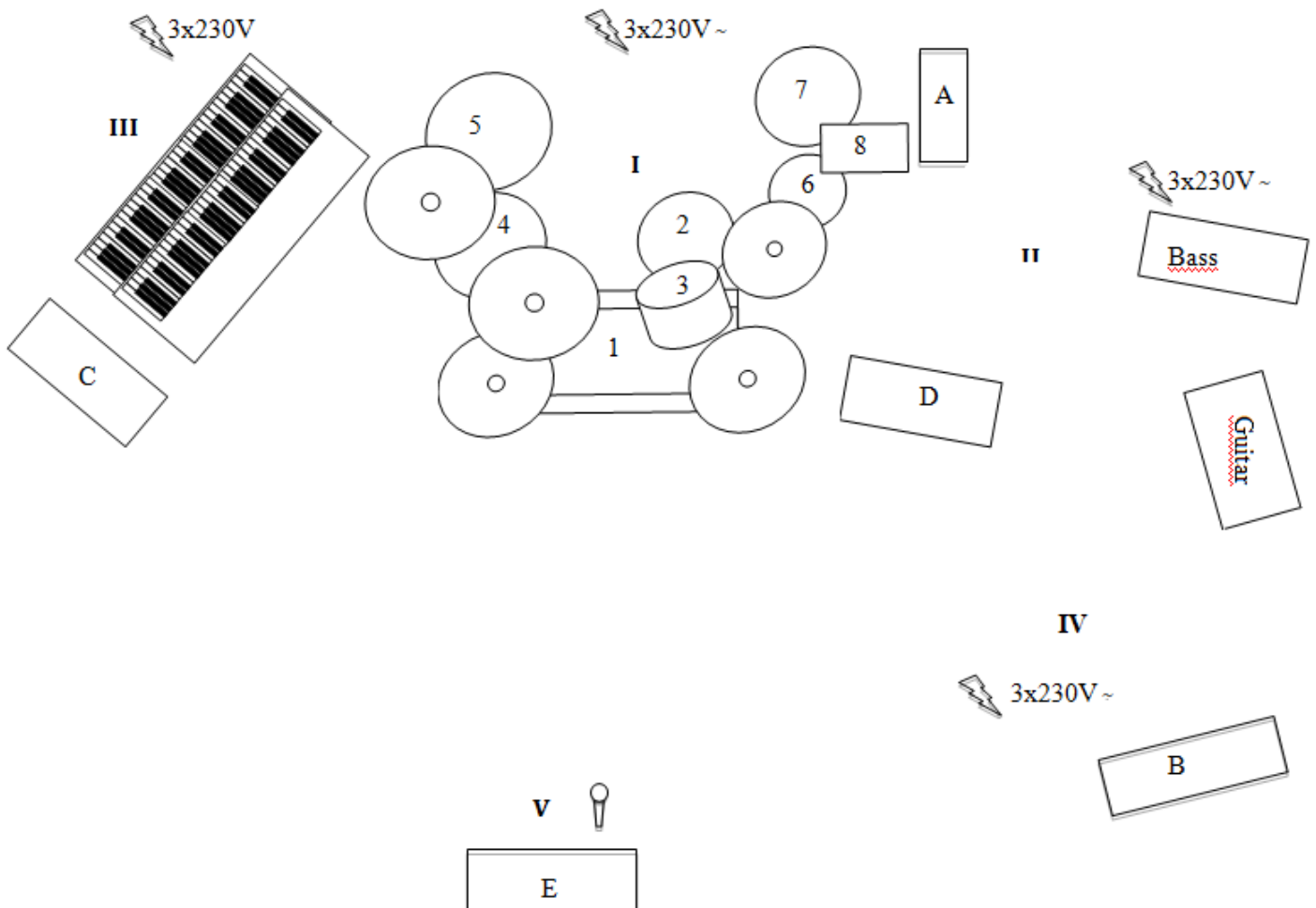

PA:	Front system must be a professional soundsystem, that can produce a clear and undistorted sound of 100 dB(A) in every area of the venue evenly.

Please provide a lockable dressing room (ready on arrival) with a fair amount of coffee, tea, lemonade and alcoholic beverages.
